JOINT PETITION OF EMBARO FLORIDA, INC. AND AT&T FLORIDA TO TRANSFER PORTIONS OF AT&T FLORIDA'S CERTIFICATED AREA TO EMBARQ AND TO AMEND CERTIFICATES

Embarq Florida, Incorporated ("Embarq) and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida") in accordance with Rules 25-4.005 and 28.106.201, Florida Administrative Code, jointly petition the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission" or "FPSC") to modify certain exchange boundaries in Seminole County and to amend the companies' certificates accordingly. In support of this petition, Embarq and AT&T Florida state as follows:

- 1. AT&T Florida is an incumbent local exchange company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Florida Statutes. AT&T Florida provides service in Florida under FPSC Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 8.
- 2. Embarq is an incumbent local exchange company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Florida Statute. Embarq provides service in Florida under FPSC Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 22.

- Embarq's principal place of business in Florida is 555 Lake Border Drive,

In this Petition, Embarq and AT&T Florida seek to amend their exchange boundaries to transfer a portion of the Provenance development currently in the AT&T Florida Oviedo Exchange to the Embarq Winter Park Exchange. The territory to be transferred consists of approximately 90 single family lots located in the Northeast Increment of the Provenance development. No subscribers reside in the areas to be transferred and the property is currently owned by the developer; therefore, no subscribers would be affected by modifying Embarq's Winter Park exchange to include this portion of the Provenance development. A Copy of the proposed service area map is attached as Exhibit "A".

- 7. The present boundary line bisects the planned subdivision and individual lots, rendering provision of service difficult. The proposed boundary change will better align the companies' exchange service areas, and will move the existing boundary to more readily discernible terrain features. The proposed change will permit revisions to the companies' boundaries so that they will not divide subdivisions and lots, thereby rendering the boundaries more usable in the provision and administration of service. Existing telephone service, local service rates, calling areas and calling plans will not be affected by these proposed changes since there are no existing customers in the areas to be transferred. Once the transfer is complete, telephone service, local service rates, calling areas and calling plans in the transferred area will be governed by Embarq's General Exchange Tariff.
- There are no pending applications for basic local service held by AT&T
 Florida or Embarq related to the territory to be transferred.
- AT&T Florida and Embarq do not currently hold any deposits or deposit interest as there are no subscribers in the area to be transferred.
- 10. No financial exchange or consideration was, or shall be, given for this proposed transfer of Certificated Areas. This Joint Petition is the only written agreement between AT&T Florida and Embarq.
- 11. Both AT&T Florida and Embarq have agreed that the requested transfer of service area is feasible from an economic standpoint and beneficial to the subscribers of both companies.

- 12. In accordance with FPSC Rule 25-4.005, Florida Administrative Code, the required Affidavit is attached to this Joint Petition as Exhibit "B." The Affidavit certifies that notice of intention to file the Petition has been given to those parties set forth in the above-cited rule. Copies of the letters referred to in the Affidavit are included as Exhibit "C." A copy of the published notice is included as Exhibit "D."
- 13. Upon the Commission's approval of the modifications proposed herein, the companies will file the final tariff sheets for administrative approval.

WHEREFORE, AT&T Florida and Embarq request that the Commission consider this Joint Petition and redefine the boundaries of the Petitioners' Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity as requested in the Petition, and enter an appropriate order to effectuate such a redefinition.




