Re: Test Year Letter Request for Mid-County Services, Inc.

Dear Mr. Marcelli:

The Commission received your letter dated April 25, 2008, requesting approval for Mid-County Services, Inc. (Mid-County) to file a rate case using a historical test year ended December 31, 2007, with pro forma plant and operating expense adjustments, for establishing final rates. Docket No. 080250-SU has been assigned to Mid-County's application for an increase in rates.

In evaluating the request, we have determined that additional information will be necessary before the Commission can make a determination as to the appropriateness of the requested test year. In accordance with Rule 25-30.430(2)2.(c), Florida Administrative Code, the test year request must include a general statement of all known estimated pro forma adjustments which will be made to the requested test year amounts. While Mid-County did include verbiage describing the types of pro forma adjustments that it anticipated including in its request, the filing is deficient as Mid-County did not provide an estimate of the pro forma adjustments.

To properly evaluate the merits of Mid-County's request, it will need to submit an estimate of the pro forma adjustments associated with plant additions and improvements, as well as, proposed changes to expense. We ask that Mid-County submit these estimates by May 30, 2008.
