INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

Progress Energy Florida, Inc., ("PEF" or "Company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), submits this Notice of Intent to Request for Confidential Classification of confidential portions of PEF's responses to Staff's Third Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 16-18). Specifically, documents responsive to question 18 contain confidential business information relating to PEF's contractual pricing arrangements between PEF and third parties that would adversely impact PEF's and third party competitive business interests if disclosed to the public. In fact, they contain information which the third parties consider to be trade secrets.


