JOINT STATUS REPORT OF CLAY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE AND PROGRESS ENERGY FLORIDA

This status report is submitted pursuant to Commission Order No. PSC-95-1434-FOF-EU, issued in Docket No. 950851-EU, which approved the currently effective territorial agreement between Clay Electric Cooperative ("Clay Electric") and Progress Energy Florida ("PEF") in Marion, Levy and Columbia counties. The purpose of this joint status report is to inform the Commission that four customers remain to be transferred from PEF to Clay due to easement problems. One customer remains to be transferred from Clay to PEF due to access issues. No date has been scheduled for the transfer of these customers. Clay Electric and PEF are currently discussing the possibility of proposing adjustments to the current agreement and anticipate these discussions will be concluded in the near future at which time Clay Electric and PEF will file a joint petition to amend the territorial agreement and request Commission approval.
