

(hereinafter referred to as "AUF" or "Applicant"), by and through its undersigned counsel and pursuant to Sections 367.081, 367.082, and 367.101, Florida Statutes, and Rules 25-30.434, 25-30.436, and 25-30.565, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files this Application for increased water and wastewater rates and increased or revised service availability charges for its systems in Alachua, Brevard, Desoto, Highlands, Lake, Lee, Marion, Orange, Palm Beach, Pasco, Polk, Putnam, Seminole, Sumter, Volusia, and Washington Counties, and for approval of allowance for funds prudently invested ("AFPI") charges for certain systems located in Highlands, Lake, Polk, Putnam, Orange, Sumter, and Washington Counties.

3. AUF was incorporated on July 2, 2003 under the laws of the State of Florida and is currently authorized to conduct business in the State of Florida.¹ AUF is a wholly-owned subsidiary of its parent company, Aqua America, Inc., ("Aqua America," formerly Philadelphia Suburban Company). Aqua America is based in Bryn Mawr, Pennsylvania and is the largest publicly traded water and wastewater utility based in the United States providing service to more than 3,000,000 customers in thirteen states. 4. AUF provides water and wastewater service in eighty-two service areas (57 water and 25 wastewater service areas) in 16 counties pursuant to certificates issued by the Commission. As a result of a corporate reorganization, AUF became the sole share holder of the Commission-regulated water and wastewater systems that are the subject of this Application. AUF's corporate reorganization was acknowledged by the Commission in Order No. PSC-06-0973-FOF-WS issued November 22, 2006, in Docket No. 060643-WS, effective November 22, 2006.

5. Attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"** is a list of each system organized by county showing with the number of the last Commission docket and Order in which the rates for each system were previously established and/or approved by the Commission.

6. Attached hereto as **Exhibit "B"** is a list of addresses of each location within each county affected by this Application where the Application and supporting documents will be available for customer inspection during the time the rate case is pending. A copy of this Application and supporting documents will also be made available for public inspection at AUF's local offices during regular business hours at the following addresses:

7. An affidavit signed by John M. Lihvarcik, the President and Chief Operating Officer of AUF, stating that the Applicant will comply with the noticing requirements set forth in Rules 25-22.0407 and 25-30.4345, Florida Administrative Code, for applications for water and wastewater rate increases, increased or revised service availability charges, and approval of AFPI charges is attached hereto as **Exhibit "C"**.

8. AUF requests that this Application be scheduled for a formal administrative hearing rather than the Proposed Agency Action procedure outlined in Section 367.081(8), Florida Statutes.

9. Two checks in the amount of \$9,000 and \$4,500 accompany this Application as the filing fees required by Section 367.091(6), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.020, Florida Administrative Code, for AUF's requests for increased water and wastewater rates and increased or revised service availability charges, respectively.

10. Except as may be specifically identified herein, AUF does not know of any manner in which this Application deviates from the policies, procedures or guidelines prescribed by relevant rules.

11. There has been no new land recorded on AUF's books since rate base was last established for each of the eighty-two systems through various Commission Orders.

II. APPLICATION FOR INCREASE IN WATER AND WASTEWATER RATES

12. Sixteen copies of AUF's Financial, Rate and Engineering Minimum Filing Requirements ("MFRs"), in accordance with Rule 25-30.437, Florida Administrative Code and Form PSC/ECR 19, have been filed contemporaneously herewith. Attached hereto as **Exhibit "D"** is an Index to the MFRs.

13. Sixteen copies of the Direct Testimonies of AUF's witnesses Robert M. Griffin, John M. Lihvarcik, Stephen F. Anzaldo, John F. Guastella, Stanley F. Szczgiel, Christopher H. Franklin, William T. Rendell, Dan Franceski, and Gary S. Prettyman filed in support of this Application and MFRs in accordance with Rule 25-30.436(2), Florida Administrative Code, have been filed contemporaneously herewith.

14. One copy of a detailed map per water and wastewater system, showing the location and size of each system's distribution and collection lines, its plant sites, and the location and respective classification of each system's customers, are labeled Volume IV to the MFRs and filed herewith pursuant to Rule 25-30.440(1), Florida Administrative Code.

15. Two copies of Volume V to the MFRs containing the Additional Engineering Information required by Rule 25-30.440(2) – (10), Florida Administrative Code, are included with the MFRs filed herewith.

16. Two copies of Volume VI to the MFRs containing Schedule E-14, entitled Billing Analysis Schedules as required by Rule 25-30.437(4), Florida Administrative Code, are included with the MFRs filed herewith.

III. INTERIM RATES

17. Pursuant to Section 367.082, Florida Statutes, AUF also seeks the authority to collect interim rates until the effective date of the Commission's Final Order on AUF's Application for increase in rates. AUF's request for interim rates is based on the historic test year ended December 31, 2007. In accordance with Rule 25-30.437(5), Florida Administrative Code, included with the MFRs filed herewith, AUF has submitted schedules reflecting rate base, cost of capital, and net operating income on an historical basis, with schedules of all adjustments thereto, supporting the granting of interim rates. These schedules demonstrate that AUF is earning below its range of reasonable return as calculated in accordance with Section 367.082(5), Florida Statutes.

Consistent with the statutory provision for calculating interim rate relief as contained in Section 367.082, Florida Statutes, AUF is entitled to an interim increase of

\$2.9 million for water and \$3.0 million for wastewater due to the financial impact of regulatory lag in this case and AUF's current financial situation. However, AUF is proposing to recognize its proposed final consolidation of rates by capping interim bills at the same level proposed in its final rate structure. In this manner, customers will not experience a high increase in interim bills, then, subsequently receive a reduction in their final bills due to a change in AUF's final rate structure. AUF has taken into consideration several very important aspects of its case relating to its interim rate proposal including: (1) affordability of rates; (2) minimizing rate shock; (3) rate continuity; and (4) its proposed final rate proposal of consolidated rates.

AUF proposes to defer recovery of this interim revenue shortfall by amortizing it over a two-year period. If this proposal is approved, AUF is willing to forego a rate of return by not placing a regulatory asset in its rate base calculation. If AUF's recovery mechanism is not approved, the Company is proposing to place into effect the total amount it is entitled to under interim rates, *subject to refund with interest*. A comparison of the full recovery of interim rates and the interim rates under AUF's proposal is provided in the MFR G Schedules.

IV. SERVICE AVAILABILITY AND AFPI CHARGES

18. Pursuant to Section 367.101, Florida Statutes and Rules 25-30.565 and 25-30.434, Florida Administrative Code, AUF also requests the approval of increased or revised service availability charges for all of the systems included in this Application, and AFPI charges for certain systems located in Highlands, Lake, Polk, Putnam, Orange, Sumter, and Washington Counties.

19. Attached hereto as **Exhibit "E"** is a list of each system organized by county, along with the number of the last Commission docket and Order, if any, in which the service availability charges for each system was previously established and/or approved by the Commission. Attached hereto as **Exhibit "F"** is a list of each system included in this application wherein the establishment of an AFPI charge is being requested, organized by county, along with the number of the last Commission docket and Order, if any, in which an AFPI charge was previously established and/or approved by the Commission.

20. Pursuant to the noticing requirements set forth in Rule 25-30.4345, upon filing this Application, and upon approval by Staff of the notices of the Application for Increased or Revised Service Availability Charges and for Approval of AFPI Charges, AUF will have such notices: (a) published in a newspaper of general circulation in the service areas included in the Application; and (b) mailed or hand delivered to all persons in the service areas included in the Application who have filed a written request for service or who have been provided a written estimate for service within the 12 calendar months prior to the month this Application is filed. Copies of these notices will be promptly filed as **Late Filed Exhibit "G"** to this Application. AUF also will provide copies of the published notice to the Commission upon receiving confirmation of each publication.

21. The information and schedules required by Rule 25-30.434, Florida Administrative Code, in support of AUF's request for the establishment of AFPI charges, are contained in Volume II of the MFRs filed herewith.

22. The information and schedules supporting AUF's request for increased service availability charges are contained in Volume III of the MFRs filed herewith.

23. A copy of this Application and the supporting exhibits for an increase in service availability charges and for establishment of AFPI charges shall be made available for public inspection at AUF's local office located in Sarasota and Leesburg Florida, during the office's regular posted business hours, as well as at each location listed in **Exhibit "B."**

WHEREFORE, AUF respectfully requests that the Commission:


A. Accept jurisdiction of this Application for increased water and wastewater rates, revised service availability charges and establishment of AFPI charges;



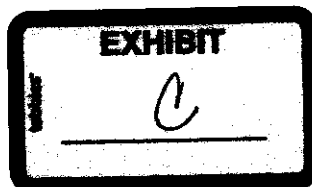

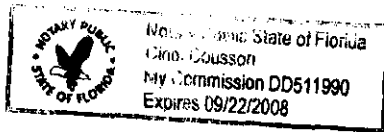
