apparent violation of Rules 25-24.470, F.A.C., Registration Required, and 25-
22.032(6)(b), F.A.C., Customer Complaints.

On August 10, 2007, Docket No. 070560-TI was opened to address Virtual Reach Corporation's failure to comply with Rules 25-24.470 and 25-22.032(6)(b), Florida Administrative Code. By Order No. PSC-07-0808-PAA-TI, issued October 8, 2007, the Commission ordered that Virtual Reach Corporation be penalized in the amount of \$65,000. The company filed a protest to the Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order on October 29, 2007. However, the Commission dismissed the company's protest with prejudice and in Final Order No. PSC-08-0227-FOF-TI, issued on April 7, 2008, ordered that the PAA Order be reinstated and consummated as a final order. The Commission further ordered that the penalty be referred to the Division of Financial Services for collection if the Commission does not receive the company's payment within 14 calendar days of the issuance date of the Final Order.

More than 14 calendar days have elapsed since the Final Order was issued and the company's payment has not been received. Accordingly, the Commission sent the penalty to the Department of Financial Services on May 14, 2008, for further collection efforts as required by the PAA Order. Therefore, this docket should be closed administratively.
