#### PROPOSED JULY 2008 DATA NOTIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida") is considering making the changes described in this document to generate results for the July 2008 data month. Results for the July 2008 data month will be posted as follows:

Preliminary results August 20, 2008 Final results August 29, 2008

AT&T Florida provides Data Notifications each month in compliance with the SQM Plan. This order specifies that when AT&T Florida proposes making any changes to the methods by which performance data is calculated, it must provide written notice. This notice must be provided on the first business day of the month before the data month in which the change will be made. AT&T Florida must also provide notification if it is considering making changes to the method of calculating data for the following month.

ENCORE Releases may affect monthly data flows from the source systems (e.g., LEO, LESOG, etc.) that PMAP uses to calculate measurements. AT&T Florida will make changes to PMAP to ensure that data continues to be correctly captured as ENCORE Releases are implemented.

System releases related to the merger between BellSouth and AT&T may affect monthly data flows from the source systems that PMAP uses to calculate measurements. AT&T Florida will make changes to PMAP to ensure that data continues to be correctly captured as system changes are implemented.

### **Ordering Measurements**

(1) Affected Measures: O-8 (RI – Reject Interval)

Description of Change: This measure should only capture responses that AT&T Florida sends to a CLEC's LSR or ASR that are clarifications. AT&T Florida discovered that for Local Interconnection Trunks, when the CLEC sends in a corrected ASR, these CLEC corrections are being counted as clarifications in error. AT&T Florida proposes to modify the code to be in accordance with the business rules so that these CLEC corrections are not counted as clarifications by AT&T Florida. This proposed change was item (1) on the Preliminary July 2008 Data Notification filed on May 1, 2008. (RQ9401)

*Impact of Change*: For July 2007 the Florida metric would have changed from 84.06% to 100.00%. Due to the impact of this change, re-posting is not necessary.

## **Provisioning Measurements**

(2) Affected Measures: P-9 (PPT – Percent Provisioning Troubles)

Description of Change: Currently the AT&T Retail data does not display on the PMAP aggregate reports. AT&T Florida proposes to modify the code to populate the PMAP aggregate reports with the AT&T Retail data as shown on the PMAP 12-month reports. This proposed change was not listed on the Preliminary July 2008 Data Notification filed on May 1, 2008. (RQ9622)

Impact of Change: All Retail data will display on the PMAP aggregate reports. Due to the impact of this change, re-posting is not necessary.
