In processing these tariff revisions, staff found the omission of Order No. 19445 (involving the Crownwood System) from both the water and wastewater tariff. An entry was made in the water tariff to correct this omission, and a revised sheet has been prepared for the wastewater tariff. Please ensure that the tariff sheets are incorporated into Utilities Inc.'s water and wastewater tariffs and are maintained on file at the utility office.

Also enclosed is a copy of Order No. PSC-07-0950-FOF-WS, which has the utility's certificate in Marion County attached as the last page. This Order replaces the Commission's former water and wastewater certificates, and should be retained by the utility.
