Order No, PSC-07-0036-FOF-TL, issued January 10, 2007, provided that Docket No. 060598-TL remain open for a period of time to allow staff to verify the collected amount for storm-cost recovery does not exceed the amount authorized. BellSouth was authorized to recover a maximum of \$34.6 million through its Petition by charging a \$0.50/month charge per access line over a 12-month period.

AT&T provided a letter on May 6, 2008, advising the PSC that it billed \$30,309,823.50 over the 12-month period beginning February 2, 2007, through February 1, 2008. The amount billed by AT&T did not exceed the requested cost-recovery amount. CMP staff has completed its review as required by Order No, PSC-07-0036-FOF-TL. However, this docket is in litigation status and should remain open at this time.
