

AFFIDAVIT OF PAUL MARKOVICH

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Paul Markovich who, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. My name is Paul Markovich. I am currently employed by Green Mountain Energy Company (GMEC) as Senior Vice President. My business address is 300 West 6th Street, 9th Floor, Austin, Texas. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated in this affidavit.

2. With respect to Exhibit C, I have reviewed the documents that are included in Exhibit A to FPL's Request for Confidential Classification of Information. The information which is asserted by GMEC to be proprietary confidential business information includes information that GMEC is prohibited from disclosing pursuant to its contractual obligations to third parties or specific contractual terms with Florida Power & Light which are competitively sensitive to GMEC in terms of its negotiations and contractual relationships with other parties.

3. GMEC has had no objection and continues to have no objection to the full disclosure of this information to the Florida Public Service Commission and its Staff to allow them to fulfill their regulatory function; however, certain portions, if publicly disclosed, would impair the competitive business of GMEC and harm its business operations. GMEC has maintained the confidentiality of these documents and materials.

4. Consistent with the provisions of the Florida Administrative Code, these documents should remain confidential for a period of not less than 18 months. In addition, it should be returned to GMEC as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business, so that GMEC can continue to maintain the confidentiality of these documents.

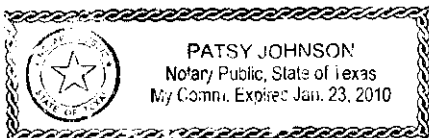
