Does Gulf agree that the adjustment in Question 1 is necessary because the E1-B Schedule is a twelve-month form, yet following a mid-course correction as petitioned for by Gulf, with part of the estimated July End-of-Period Total Net True-up being collected in September through December, the estimated December End-of-Period Total Net True-up technically would be a "four-month-period End-of-Period Total Net True-up?"

GULF'S RESPONSE:

The calculation of the December End-of-Period Total Net True-up reflects the revised over/under-recovery amounts and interest provisions using Gulf's requested cost recovery factors for the period September through December 2008 along with the deferral of a portion of the estimated End-of-Period Total Net True-up as of August 2008.
