We will check with all the Commissioners to make sure that there are no questions, and if none of the Commissioners have questions, then those witnesses may be excused.

We would also like to note that staff will prepare an exhibit list which will include all the prefiled exhibits as well as a staff proposed stipulated exhibit that we will prepare and provide to the parties prior to the hearing.

21 We would like to note that there is one pending 22 confidentiality matter which will be addressed by separate 23 order.

And as far as any rulings, staff would suggest that opening statements, if any, be limited to ten minutes.
