

**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S NOTICE OF INTENT
TO SEEK CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION
OF PORTIONS OF MFR SCHEDULE D-2**

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a)(1), Florida Administrative Code, hereby gives notice of intent to request confidential classification of certain information that is contained in MFR Schedule D-2 (Bates stamp pages 7 and 8), and states:

1. Rule 25-22.006(3)(a) provides in material part "prior to the Staff obtaining any material, a utility or other person may receive temporary exemption from Section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, by filing a notice of intent to request confidential classification." Rule 25-22.006(3)(d) provides in material part, "All material that . . . is subject to a notice of intent to request confidential classification . . . shall be exempt from Section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and will be accorded stringent internal procedural safeguards against public disclosure."

2. Tampa Electric Company's MFR Schedule D-2 contains confidential proprietary business information of Tampa Electric. Accordingly, Tampa Electric intends to seek confidential classification with respect to that confidential information.

3. The confidential material that is the subject of MFR Schedule D-2 will be submitted to the Commission under a separate transmittal letter marked "Confidential," with redacted versions furnished to the Staff. Tampa Electric requests that the Commission maintain the confidentiality of




