Dear Ms. Cole:

This letter will confirm our understanding regarding the Commission Staff's request that Peoples Gas System ("Peoples" or the "Company") waive the statutory requirement for Commission action on the Company's petition and tariff filing in the above docket (under the file-and-suspend provisions of Section 366.06(3), *Florida Statutes*) in connection with the Staff's need and desire for the Commission to have an additional period of approximately two months within which to dispose of such petition and tariff filing.

The Company hereby agrees to an extension, to and including May 19, 2009, of the time for the Commission to dispose of the Company's petition and tariff filing in the above docket to meet the requirements of the file-and-suspend provisions of Section 366.06(3), *Florida Statutes*, subject to:

1. the Commission's disposition of the Company's Petition for Interim Rate Relief in the above docket at the Commission's Agenda Conference on September 29, 2008; and
2. the Commission's final disposition of the Company's Petition for authority to increase its rates and charges, and for other relief, no later than the Commission's Agenda Conference on May 19, 2009.
