RE: Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel - Docket No. 080559-TL – Petition for expedited review of NXX-X code denial by Number Pooling Administrator for the Clay Street switch within the Jacksonville exchange by AT&T.

On August 13, 2008, AT&T Florida, Inc., (AT&T) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for the Jacksonville exchange, Clay Street (JCVLFLCLDS0) switch. AT&T requested a full NXX to meet the request of a specific customer for 10,000 consecutive numbers in the format NPA NX7-XXXX. On August 13, 2008, AT&T's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust and utilization criteria.

On August 18, 2008, AT&T filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order No. PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the AT&T petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) The customer will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (September 5, 2008), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide AT&T the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Jacksonville exchange, Clay Street (JCVLFLCLDS0) switch. Please allow staff assigned to the docket to review the Order before it is issued. If you have any questions, please call Jim Polk at (850) 413-6510.
