

Re: Application of Aqua Utilities, Inc.

Dear Mr. White:

This is in response to your letter objection to the Florida Public Service Commission, dated August 24, 2008, which you provided me with a copy.

From your letter it appears that your major concern is related to whether Aqua Utilities, Inc.'s application, if granted, would adversely impact the water flows from the well serving your residence. To that point, the Aqua amendment is a request to amend its service territory certificate to include 23 customers who are currently being served by its facilities at Haines Creek. Continuing to serve these 23 customers will clearly have no impact on the availability of water to you or others in the area.

In addition to continuing to serve these 23 current customers, Aqua has requested authority to serve an additional 7 lots that are located adjacent to its current water facilities. Aqua has determined that there is more than an adequate water supply to cover these additional 7 lots based on its permitted water withdrawal capacity of 64,800 gallons per day, as compared to its current customer maximum service demand of 29,000 gallons per day, which occurred this August.

Given the more than adequate capacity of Aqua's facilities located at Haines Creek, Aqua believes there will be no adverse effect on any current customer's service by having either the 23 current customers added to its certificated service territory or by the inclusion of the additional 7 lots.
