Hi Marguerite

My records indicate that in Docket 060644 dealing with Embarq Storm Cost, the involved audit documents are:

- 10730-06 Wp's -- Claimed Confidential
- 10731-06 Wp's -- Claimed Confidential
- 10732-06 Audit Report -- Requested and granted Confidential PSC Order No. PSC-07-0231 Declassifying on Sept 13, 2008
- 10630-06 Testimony -- Requested and granted Confidential PSC Order No. PSC-07-0231 Declassifying on Sept 13, 2008

Recommended treatment 10730-06 and 10731-06 should be kept as claimed until 5 years after docket closes.

Documents 10732-06 and 10630-06 could go to the docket file after waiting 21 days to see if any other filings are made -- noting such on the WP records 10730-06 and 10731-06, so some future auditor can follow the trail.
