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INDIANTOWN GAS COMPANY'S PRELIMINARY LIST OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Pursuant to Order No. PSC-08-0170-PCO-GU, issued March 20, 2008 and Order No. PSC-08-0363-PCO-GU, issued May 30, 2008, establishing the prehearing procedure in this docket, Indiantown Gas Company ("Company") hereby files its Preliminary List of Issues and Positions.

ISSUE 1: What are the final conservation cost recovery true-up amounts for the period January 2007 through December 2007?

IGC POSITION: \$1,390 over-recovery, including interest.

ISSUE 2: What are the actual/estimated conservation cost recovery true-up amounts for the period January 2008 through December 2008?

IGC POSITION: \$21,610 over-recovery.

ISSUE 3: What are the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected during the period January 2009 through December 2009?

IGC POSITION: \$7,378 to be recovered during January 2009 through December 2009.

ISSUE 4: What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2009 through December 2009?

IGC POSITION: The appropriate conservation cost recovery factors for Indiantown Gas Company for the period January 2009 through December 2009 are as follows:
