NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to Rule 25-22.080(3), Florida Administrative Code, that the Florida Public Service Commission has received the petition of JEA for a determination of need for a proposed electrical power plant in Duval County. The petitioner is requesting a determination of need for the conversion of two combustion natural gas-fired "simple cycle" combustion turbines to a 2x1 "combined cycle" configuration. The proposed conversion will be located at the existing Greenland Energy Center in Duval County, Florida and will increase overall site capacity to 522 MW by 2012. This matter has been assigned Commission Docket No. 080614-EM.


