

Re: 070626-EI, Florida Power & Light Company's (FPL's) Request for Confidential Classification concerning a portion of the staff audit report and working papers prepared during "Florida Power & Light Sunshine Energy Program Audit for the Year Ended December 31, 2007", Audit Control No. 08-086-4-1, Document Nos. 04610-08, 04611-08, 04612-08, 04613-08, 05263-08, 05621-08 and 05633-08.

Dear Ms. Cano:

Staff has reviewed FPL's request for confidential classification for certain portions of the staff audit report and working papers in response to staff's "Florida Power & Light Sunshine Energy Program Audit for the Year Ended December 31, 2007," filed on June 19, 2008, and amended on June 27, 2008, and June 30, 2008, and find the following perceived issues:

Issue 1: WP 43-1/1-1/3-1, page 8 (part); WP 43-3/1-1, pages 1 and 2; and WP 43-3/1-1/2.

Section 366.093(3)(f), Florida Statutes (F.S.), provides a public records exemption for employee personnel information unrelated to compensation, duties, qualifications and responsibilities. Within the above mentioned working papers, FPL has asked that employee names and responsibilities be granted confidential classification in instances where FPL employees were providing utility services according to the utility's tariff.

Commission policy in this area is to consider the names and duties of employees performing utility services to be public information. Please see: Order No. 25238, issued October 22, 1991 in Docket No. 900960-TL; Order No. PSC-97-0022-FOF-WS, issued January 6, 1997, in Docket No. 960451-WS; and Order No. PSC-07-0579-CFO-WS, issued July 13, 2007, in Docket No. 060368 WS.

### Issue 2:

Rule 25-22.006(4), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), in part, provides that when a utility requests confidential classification, the request shall include a copy of the materials with the sensitive information highlighted and two or more copies of the material for public use with the sensitive information redacted. The following materials were requested to be confidential; however, the highlighted or redacted copies were not provided:

WP44-2/1, pages 1 to 14, highlighted and redacted copies were not provided, and WP49-2/2, page 1, a redacted copy was not provided.

## Issue 3:

Rule 25-22.006(4), F.A.C., in part, provides that when a utility requests confidential classification the utility shall identify which material is sensitive by page and line. Staff has reviewed Exhibit C provided with the highlighted and redacted copies of the sensitive materials and find that the listing does not match the highlighted and redacted copies. After its review, staff found the following errors in reconciling Exhibit C, as modified, to the highlighted and redacted copies of the material:

WP 47-1 series, pages 14-33; WP 49-2; and WP 52-8.

# Issue 4:

Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S., provides that the Commission may grant confidential classification to contractual information if its release would harm the contracting ability of a <u>public</u> <u>utility or its affiliates</u>.

In some instances, Witness Markovich, Senior Vice President of the Green Mountain Energy Company (GMEC), is justifying the contracting ability of FPL. While Mr. Markovich's affidavit concerning GMEC's competitive business is pertinent and GMEC would experience difficulties if its internal operating information is disclosed, Mr. Markovich's affidavit is not conclusive regarding FPL's contracting operations or the contracting operations of FPL's affiliates.

#### Issue 5:

Rule 25-22.006(4), F.A.C., in part, provides that when a utility requests confidential classification the utility shall identify which material is sensitive by page and line. The utility has made a number of modifications to its filing to include reductions in the amount of material requested for confidential treatment.

Staff has made a preliminary, detailed finding concerning what material is contained in the utility's request (Attachment 1); however, staff is not fully certain that this listing is correct. Please review Attachment 1 to ensure staff and FPL are recognizing the same information as sensitive.
