C. STATEMENT OF BASIC POSITION

PGS's Statement of Basic Position:

The Commission should approve PGS's end-of-period final true-up amount of \$5,922,525 (overrecovery) for the period January 2007 through December 2007; the estimated true-up amount for the period January 2008 through December 2008; and the projected conservation program expenses for the period January 1 2009 through December 31, 2009.

The Commission should approve the following ECCR factors for the following rate classes for the period January 1 through December 31, 2009:

**ISSUE 2: What are the actual/estimated conservation cost recovery true-up amounts for the period January 2008 through December 2008?**

PGS: \$2,921,911 overrecovery (Floyd)

**ISSUE 3: What are the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected**

during the period January 2009 through December 2009?

PGS: \$4,047,089 (Floyd)

**ISSUE 4: What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2008 through December 2008?**

**ISSUE 5: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?**

PGS: The factors should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2009 through December 2009. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2009, and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2009, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective. (Floyd)
