1 25-4.023 Report of Interruptions.

2 ~~(1)~~ The Commission shall be informed of any ~~major~~ interruptions to service which are the  
3 result of a tropical system named by the National Hurricane Center that affect 1,000 or more  
4 subscribers for a period of 30 minutes or more as soon as it comes to the attention of the  
5 utility. On a daily basis, the Company shall provide the time, the location, the number of  
6 subscribers affected, and the expected/estimated duration of the outage and when the  
7 interruption is restored.

8 ~~(2)~~ In addition, a copy of all Florida service interruption reports made to the Federal  
9 Communications Commission in accordance with the provisions of Part 63 of Chapter 1 of  
10 Title 47, Code of Federal Regulations, Notification of Common Carriers of Service  
11 Disruptions (Effective April 12, 1996) shall be immediately forwarded to the Commission's  
12 Division of Competitive Markets and Enforcement, Bureau of Service Quality.
