Dear Ms. Fleming,

Florida Power & Light Company has reviewed the issues identified by Staff and included in your letter dated October 9, 2008. I have provided below a brief response to each issue. Additionally, please find enclosed a Revised Exhibit C, which together with the responses below, should resolve each issue identified by Staff.

<u>Issue 1</u> (Employee Names)

WP 43-1/1-1/3-1, page 8; WP 43-3/1-1, pgs. 1 and 2; WP 43-3/1-1/2: Staff has asserted that FPL has requested confidential classification of employee names and responsibilities. However, only employee names (not responsibilities) are identified as confidential information in FPL's request. It is FPL's position that names themselves are "unrelated to compensation, duties, qualifications and responsibilities" and accordingly warrant confidential treatment pursuant to section 366.093(3)(f), Florida Statutes. Moreover, it is important to recognize that the Commission has in some instances determined that employee names are confidential information pursuant to section 366.093(3)(f). See Docket No. 060001-EI, Order No. PSC-06-0949-FOF-EI; see also Docket No. 900038-EI, Order No. 24802. Nonetheless, in this instance, FPL has determined that this information no longer requires confidential treatment. Revised Exhibit C has been amended accordingly.

Issue 2 (Provision of Highlighted and Redacted Copies)

WP 44-2/1: This document was originally identified as not requiring confidential treatment on FPL's original Exhibit C, and was then identified as confidential on FPL's June 27, 2008 Exhibit C, in error. Revised Exhibit C has been amended to reflect the original, non-confidential designation. Because FPL is not requesting confidential classification of this document, a highlighted and redacted copy was not provided.

WP 49-2/2, pg. 1: Page 1 of this document was identified as confidential in error. In fact, no page 1 was provided to FPL by the auditing team when it concluded its audit work. Revised Exhibit C has been amended accordingly. Because FPL is not requesting confidential classification of this document, a highlighted and redacted copy was not provided.

<u>Issue 3</u> (Reconciliation of Highlighted and Redacted Copies with Exhibit C)

WP 47-1, pgs. 14-33: These pages were never subject to any amended request. However, edits to FPL's June 27, 2008 Exhibit C caused an inadvertent shift in the column indicating whether a page was confidential ("Y") or not ("N"), such that it no longer lined up with the appropriate page reference. Revised Exhibit C included herewith corrects this error. This Revised Exhibit C is consistent with the redacted and highlighted copies provided with FPL's original filing on June 19, 2008.

WP 49-2: Revised Exhibit C has been amended to identify line 6 on page 1 as the only confidential material. Revised Exhibit C is now consistent with the redacted and highlighted copies provided with FPL's Amended Request on June 27, 2008.

WP 52-8: All ten pages of this document are confidential. The Exhibit Cs previously provided identified pages 1-17, as opposed to pages 1-10, in error. Revised Exhibit C has been amended to reference the appropriate page numbers. Revised Exhibit C is now consistent with the redacted and highlighted copies provided with FPL's original filing on June 19, 2008.

<u>Issue 4</u> (Green Mountain Information)

Staff expressed concern that Mr. Markovich's affidavit was being used to support the contracting ability of FPL under subsection 366.093(3)(d). Mr. Markovich is identified in Exhibit C where the information provided is considered to be proprietary, confidential business information by Green Mountain Energy Company ("Green Mountain"). Any reference to subsection 366.093(3)(d) was intended to indicate that the document contained contractual terms between Green Mountain and third parties and/or that the document's public release would impair Green Mountain's contracting ability. As noted in Mr. Markovich's affidavit, this information is also competitively sensitive to Green Mountain, and as such, it is protected by subsection 366.093(3)(e). In response to Staff's concern, references to subsection 366.093(3)(d) have been deleted for the documents in Revised Exhibit C which refer to Mr. Markovich's affidavit only. Subsection 366.093(3)(e) is sufficient to support the requested confidential classification. Revised Exhibit C reflects these adjustments.

<u>Issue 5</u> (Review of Information Identified as Confidential)

FPL has reviewed Staff's Attachment 1 and agrees with the listing of confidential information provided therein with two exceptions:

- (i) Pages 12-15 of work paper 5-7 were inadvertently omitted from FPL's original Exhibit C and June 27, 2008 Exhibit C, and are not included in Staff's Attachment 1. Revised Exhibit C included herewith includes those page references. Redacted and highlighted copies of those pages were included in FPL's original filing on June 19, 2008.
- (ii) Staff has identified lines 1, 11-12, 14-15, 19, 23, 25-26, 29-35, 37-38, and 40-41 in WP 44 p. 2 as confidential. FPL's June 27, 2008 Amendment narrowed the scope of its request to lines 1 and 14-15 only.
