

Over the years, Aloha has refused to correct the black water problems and has refused to make available incremental improvements. The current settlement foisted on the customers is clearly not appropriate and is not fixing the many customer problems.

Sale of the utility is the only reasonable resolution to these Aloha Utilities problem. The PSC is requested to insist on completion of the sale or deletion of this very negligent water utility.

If the sale is not completed in December 2008, it will only because of additional delays created by the greedy Aloha Utility owner. It appears that the utility is being uncooperative with the FGUA just as they have been with the Aloha customers over the past 15 years. We have been told that the utility will not allow the FGUA to keep the customers informed on the progress towards the sale.
