# PROGRESS ENERGY FLORIDA INC.'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Progress Energy Florida, Inc., ("PEF" or "Company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), submits this Request for Confidential Classification for certain information provided in response to OPC's Third Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 25-44) propounded on PEF. In support of this Request, PEF states:

- 1. In response to OPC's Third Request for Production of Documents, PEF will provide responses containing information that is "proprietary business information" under Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes.
  - 2. The following exhibits are included with this request:
- (a) Sealed Composite Exhibit A is a package containing unreducted copies of all the documents for which PEF seeks confidential treatment. Composite Exhibit A is being submitted separately in a sealed envelope labeled "CONFIDENTIAL." In the unreducted versions, the information asserted to be confidential is highlighted by yellow marker.

information for which confidential treatment is requested has been blocked out by opaque marker or other means.

- (c) Exhibit C is a table which identifies by page and line the information for which PEF seeks confidential classification and the specific statutory bases for seeking confidential treatment.
- 3. As indicated in Exhibit C, the information for which PEF requests confidential classification is "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), F.S. Specifically, the information at issue relates to competitively negotiated contractual data, such as pricing and quantities of coal, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the Company or its affiliates to negotiate coal supply contracts on favorable terms. See § 366.093(3)(d), F.S.; Affidavit of Sasha Weintraub at ¶ 5. The information at issue also relates to confidential studies which concern proprietary business information and were prepared by third parties. See § 366.093(3)(d), F.S.; Affidavit of Sasha Weintraub at ¶ 6. Furthermore, the information at issue relates to the competitive interests of PEF and its coal suppliers, the disclosure of which would impair their competitive businesses. Id. § 366.093(3)(e); Affidavit of Sasha Weintraub at ¶ 5. Accordingly, such information constitutes "proprietary confidential business information" which is exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Act pursuant to Section 366.093(1), F.S.
- 4. The information identified as Exhibit "A" is intended to be and is treated as confidential by the Company. See Affidavit of Sasha Weintraub at ¶ 7. The information has not been disclosed to the public, and the Company has treated and continues to treat the information and contracts at issue as confidential. See Affidavit of Sasha Weintraub at ¶ 7.

5. PEF requests that the information identified in Exhibit A be classified as "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of section 366.093(3), F.S., that the information remain confidential for a period of at least 18 months as provided in section 366.093(4) F.S., and that the information be returned as soon as it is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business..

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, PEF respectfully requests that this Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
