Dear Ms. Cole:

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code, Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and other applicable law, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida") herewith files its Claim of Confidential Classification for the Commission's Staff's April OSS Release audit report, all audit work papers, and all documents provided to Staff in connection with the audit report. In support of this claim, AT&T Florida states as follows. In September 2008, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") Staff commenced an audit into AT&T Florida's April OSS software release ("April Release"). See Commission Order No. PSC-08-0618-PAA-TP, dated September 23, 2008 (accepting the parties' agreement regarding the scope of an April Release audit conducted by Staff). On November 26, 2008, provided AT&T Florida a draft audit report entitled "AT&T's OSS April 2008 Release Analysis and Resolutions" ("Draft Report"). Among other things, Staff requested AT&T to request confidential treatment of the portions of the Draft Report that AT&T Florida considers confidential by December 16, 2008.

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of people necessary to perform the review function properly, AT&T Florida needs additional time to complete its review of the Draft Report.

Accordingly, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code, Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and other applicable law, AT&T hereby claims the entire Draft Report including all audit work paper and documents provided in response to Staff's Data Requests to be proprietary confidential business information. The aforementioned information is valuable, AT&T Florida treats this information as confidential, and the information is not generally disclosed. Further, the disclosure of this confidential information without appropriate protective safeguards may cause harm to AT&T Florida, and thus is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Florida law.

On or before January 9, 2009, AT&T Florida intends to submit written comments in response to the staff's Draft Report, and also intends to file a more detailed Request for Confidential Classification in accordance with paragraphs (3) and (4) of Commission Rule 25-22.006.

For the reasons set forth herein, AT&T Florida respectfully claims the Draft Report including all audit work paper and documents provided in response to Staff's Data Requests to be proprietary confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes and other applicable law.
