Q9) Would PEF agree with the calculated over-recovery in the attached table entitled "Components of Progress Energy 2009 Mid-Course Recovery"? If not, would you provide a table with the utility's corrections and PEF's explanation of those corrections?

Answer: PEF agrees with the calculated over-recovery in the "Components of Progress Energy 2009 Mid-Course Recovery" table. In PEF's petition, PEF requested a fuel rate reduction of \$205,842,083 (Schedule E1-D, Line 3), which amounts to a .69 cent/kwh reduction. The difference between the amount filed and the amount calculated on the table of \$204,691,147 is \$1,150,936 or approximately .04 cents/kwh. Since actual fuel prices and sales volumes often materialize at different amounts than those filed in projections, PEF would propose to adhere to its original filing to reduce fuel prices by \$205,842,083.
