Dear Ms. Cole:

This law firm represents Sun River Utilities, Inc., and has received Regulatory Assessment Fee Return forms for the period 01/01/2008 to 05/21/2008 (copies of which are attached). As the Commission is aware, in September 2007, Charlotte County took back jurisdiction over water and wastewater utilities located within that County. Although there was a pending docketed item over which the Commission retained jurisdiction, all other purposes' jurisdiction was transferred to Charlotte County. In fact, Charlotte County is demanding that Sun River Utilities, Inc., pays regulatory assessment fees for 2008, including the period for which the Public Service Commission is seeking the payment of regulatory assessment fees by Sun River Utilities, Inc. While Sun River believes that the regulatory assessment fees are due to Charlotte County, it is not opposed to paying those fees to the Florida Public Service Commission so long as it does not have to pay them twice. Therefore, you can see the dilemma in which Sun River Utilities, Inc., finds itself.

Please address this matter with the Commission's General Counsel and advise me as to whether the Commission is insistent on payment of regulatory assessment fees for a portion of 2008, to the Commission.

I look forward to hearing from the Commission regarding this matter.
