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REQUEST TO WITHDRAW CERTIFICATE

CBB Carrier Service, Inc. ("CBB") hereby requests that the Florida Public Service Commission cancel its Certificate to Provide Competitive Local Exchange Telecommunications Service¹ pursuant to Section 25-24.820(2) of the Florida Administrative Code.²

I. Statement of intent and date certain to pay regulatory assessment fee.

CBB's check for payment of the 2008 regulatory fee in the amount of \$672, which represents the \$600.00 minimum fee, plus a \$60.00 late penalty and \$12.00 interest fee, was mailed to Public Service Commission on March 12, 2009.

II. Statement of why the certificate is proposed to be cancelled.

CBB is not currently offering service in Florida and has no customers in Florida. Although CBB had customers in Florida in the past, its last customer discontinued all service with CBB in September 2007. Going forward, CBB's business plan does not include plans to offer telecommunications services in Florida. As a result, CBB seeks to reduce its overall

regulatory filing obligations by cancelling its Certificate to Provide Competitive Local Exchange Telecommunications Service.

CBB has no customers in Florida, so it will not be issuing a notice of discontinuance of service.


