CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY TRUE-UP AMOUNT**



In support hereof, the Company states:

- 1) On May 4, 2008, Sebring Gas filed its petition, testimony and exhibits in this docket. Upon a subsequent review, it was found that incorrect interest rates had been mistakenly used for some months in 2008 which caused the calculations to change. With the changes, the overrecovery is \$17,200.00
