

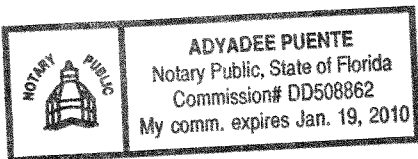

The Florida Public Service Commission approved the attached tariff sheet implementing the Florida Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP's) requirement that customers with backflow prevention devices cause the devices to be inspected at least annually. O & S Water Company will continue to send annual reminders to customers who have backflow prevention devices, along with a list of plumbing technicians who are certified in backflow inspection.

The Commission authorizes the Utility to discontinue service, after five days written notice, to any customer with a backflow prevention device that fails to provide documentation of an annual inspection. The utility's objective is compliance with the DEP's requirement for annual inspection and requests that O & S' customers share that goal.
