**FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S
MOTION FOR TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER**

Pursuant to section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006(6)(c), Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL"), hereby moves the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission"), through the Prehearing Officer, for a temporary protective order to exempt from section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, certain confidential information included in FPL's response to the Office of Public Counsel's ("OPC's") Eighth Request for Production of Documents No. 225, in Docket No. 080677-EI, and in support states:

1. OPC has requested that it be permitted to take possession of FPL's confidential, proprietary information included in FPL's response to the request for production of documents identified above.

2. Subsection (6)(c) of Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, provides in relevant part as follows with respect to a utility allowing OPC to take possession of utility information:

[T]he utility may request a temporary protective order exempting the information from Section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes. If the information is to be used in a proceeding before the Commission, then the utility must file a specific request for a protective order under paragraph (a) above. If the information is not to be used in a proceeding before the Commission, then Public Counsel shall return the information to the utility in accordance with the record retention requirements of the Department of State.
