

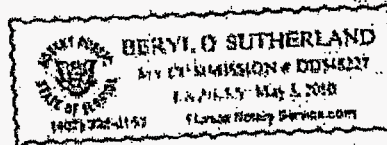

The meeting will begin as scheduled and will continue until all of the customers have been heard.

The purpose of this meeting is to give customers and other interested persons an opportunity to ask questions, to offer comments to Commission Staff regarding the utility's pending application for a revenue neutral rate restructuring proceeding, the rates included in this Notice, the quality of service the utility provides, as well as other issues. Commission Staff will be available to address and coordinate customers' comments and to assist members of the public. A representative from the Utility may also be in attendance. At the beginning of the meeting, procedures will be established for the order of comments. Commission Staff will have sign-up sheets, and customers will be called in the order that they sign up to speak. Written comments may also be sent to the Commission at the address given at the end of this notice.
