ELEVENTH NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Progress Energy Florida ("PEF" or the "Company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files this Eleventh Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of the supplemental response to White Springs Agricultural Chemicals, Inc. d/b/a PCS Phosphate - White Springs' ("White Springs") First Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 1-17), specifically request number 5, and PEF's supplemental response to Office of Public Counsel's ("OPC") Seventh Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 87-99), specifically request number 92. These responsive documents contain information regarding contractual negotiations for potential joint ownership of the Levy Nuclear Project, the release of which could harm these negotiations, and thus would harm PEF's competitive interests. These documents also contain sensitive and confidential analysis related to the financing for the Levy Nuclear Project, the disclosure of which would harm PEF's competitive business interests in obtaining financing.

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
