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**FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S AGREED
MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME FOR PARTIES TO FILE PRE-HEARING
STATEMENTS**

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL"), by and through undersigned counsel, hereby moves the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") for a six (6) day enlargement of time within which all parties shall file Pre-Hearing Statements such that Prehearing Statements will now be due on August 6, 2009, and in support thereof states as follows:

1. On March 20, 2009, the Commission entered its Order Establishing Procedure in this docket in Order No. PSC-09-0159-PCO-EI ("Order No. 09-0159"). Included within Order No. 09-0159, at Section IX ("Controlling Dates"), is a requirement for the filing of Prehearing Statements by the parties on July 31, 2009.

2. The Commission has recently scheduled the Issues Conference in this case which will take place on July 29, 2009, just 2 days before the date on which the Prehearing Statements are currently due to be filed. FPL reasonably anticipates that as a result of the discussions that will take place at the Issues Conference, the parties and Staff will likely need to revisit and revise the original lists of issues, and all concerned will be hard pressed to complete that process of review and revision to finalize issues and Prehearing Statements by July 31, 2009.

3. The relief requested in this Motion will serve to assist in the efficient administration of this case as the brief extension of time for filing Prehearing Statements will

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provide the parties adequate time following the Issues Conference to refine and finalize their issues and Prehearing Statements, while at the same time alleviating the otherwise likely need for multiple revisions and amendments to the Prehearing Statements.

4. In light of the foregoing, and in an effort to allow all parties to adequately review and incorporate into their Prehearing Statements information and issues discussed at the July 29, 2009 Issues Conference, FPL respectfully requests a six (6) day extension of time for all parties to file Prehearing Statements such that said Prehearing Statements will be due August 6, 2009. This request is made in the interest of justice and fairness, and the granting of this Motion will both serve the stated purpose and will not cause any prejudice to any party to this action or to the prompt administration of this case.

5. FPL has contacted all parties of record and has been authorized to represent that said parties consent to the granting of this motion.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, FPL respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order enlarging the time for all parties to file Pre-Hearing Statements on August 6, 2009.
