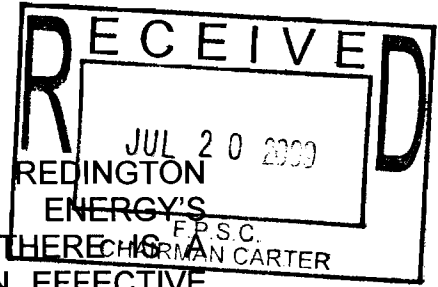

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH FLORIDA OPPOSING PROGRESS ENERGY'S REQUESTED BASE RATE INCREASE UNTIL THERE IS A CHANGE IN BASIC SERVICES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, the Town of North Redington Beach has not noticed any appreciable change to the basic services provided by Progress Energy that would warrant an increase in the base rate, and

Whereas, whenever a special interest is expressed for additional services, there is an extra charge attached, and

Whereas, that charge is always high enough to include a profit, and


Whereas, the proposed increase in the base rate is designed to drop to the profit line of Progress Energy, which is already substantial.
