**REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF INFORMATION  
PROVIDED PURSUANT TO AUDIT NO. 09-110-4-1**

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of certain information provided to the Florida Public Service Commission ("FPSC" or "Commission") staff ("Staff") in connection with Audit Control No. 09-110-4-1 (the "Audit") in this docket. In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

1. During the Audit, Staff requested access to various FPL reports and other documents, portions of which became working papers of the auditors. By letter dated July 9, 2009, Staff indicated its intent to retain certain working papers for which confidential treatment previously had been requested (the "Working Papers"). Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, FPL was given 21 days from the date of that letter, or until July 30, 2009, to file a formal request for confidential classification with respect to the Working Papers. This Request is intended to request confidential classification of the confidential portions of the Working Papers consistent with Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code.

2. The following exhibits are included with and made a part of this request:

a. Composite Exhibit A consists of copies of the Working Papers, on which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been highlighted. Composite Exhibit A is submitted separately in a sealed folder marked "CONFIDENTIAL."

b. Composite Exhibit B consists of an edited version of Exhibit A on which all information FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been redacted.

c. Exhibit C is a table containing a line-by-line and page-by-page identification of the information for which confidential classification is sought, and, with regard to each document or portions thereof, references to the specific statutory basis or bases for the claim of confidentiality and to the affidavits in support of the requested classification.

d. Exhibit D is comprised of the affidavits of Robert Onsgard, Erica A. McNabb, Edward S. Bowman, Lindley T. Graves Jr., Solomon L. Stamm, Roxanne R. Kennedy, R.M. Posso, Kenneth Getchell, Gary A. McBean, H. Antonio Cuba, Dean Girard, and Maria V. Besada.

3. FPL seeks confidential protection for the information highlighted in Exhibit A. The highlighted information is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. The information is intended to be, and has been, treated by FPL as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained.

4. Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, the information highlighted in Exhibit A is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review, such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.

5. The statutory bases for FPL's assertion of confidentiality with regard to each document or portion thereof are set forth in Exhibit C under the column titled "FLORIDA

STATUTE 366.093(3) SUBSECTION.” The letters in that column refer to the subsection(s) of Section 366.093(3) that provide justification for FPL’s request.

6. Further support for FPL’s request for confidential classification of the referenced information is provided through the affidavits that are included as Exhibit D to this Request. As the affidavits included in Exhibit D indicate, the information provided by FPL contains information relating to trade secrets. Such information is protected by section 366.093(3)(a), Florida Statutes. Additionally, the information provided by FPL includes information relating to internal auditing controls and reports of internal auditors. Such information is protected by section 366.093(3)(b), Florida Statutes. Additionally, the information provided by FPL includes information relating to security measures, systems, or procedures. This information includes, but is not limited to, auditors’ notes describing various FPL security features at FPL facilities. Such information is protected by section 366.0093(3)(c), Florida Statutes. The information provided by FPL also includes information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair FPL’s efforts to contract for goods and services on favorable terms in the future. Such information is protected by section 366.093(3)(d), Florida Statutes. Specifically, the information provided by FPL, includes, but is not limited to, negotiated contractual terms and conditions, pricing, and obligations, which if disclosed, would impair FPL’s ability to contract for certain goods and services on favorable terms in the future. The information provided by FPL also includes information that is competitively sensitive, and its disclosure would impair the competitive interests of FPL or its vendors. Specifically, the information provided by FPL includes, but is not limited to, information specific to the terms of sale of materials and services or competitively sensitive compensation information, which if disclosed, would impair FPL’s competitive interests and increase costs to customers. Such information is protected by section

366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes. *See*, Order No. PSC-05-0626-PCO-EI, issued June 7, 2005, Docket No. 050078-EI, *In re: Petition for rate increase by Progress Energy Florida, Inc.*; Order No. PSC-02-1755-CFO-GU, issued December 12, 2002, Docket No. 020384-GU, *In re: Petition for rate increase by Peoples Gas System*. Certain information provided by FPL also includes information concerning employee personnel information that is unrelated to compensation, duties, qualifications, or responsibilities. This information is protected by section 366.093(3)(f), Florida Statutes.

7. Upon a finding by the Commission that the information highlighted in Exhibit A, and referenced in Exhibit C, is proprietary confidential business information, the information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. *See* § 366.093(4), Florida Statutes.

**WHEREFORE**, for the foregoing reasons, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that this Request be granted.

Specifically, the information provided by FPL includes confidential business information contain or constitute oil financial instruments, fuel status and inventory reports, contractual data and negotiated agreements for services of FPL facilities, the disclosure of which would impair FPL's efforts to contract for goods or services on favorable terms in the future. This information, if made public, would disclose certain competitively sensitive procedures to the detriment of FPL and its customers, and would impair FPL's efforts to enter into contracts on commercially favorable terms. Additionally, the information provided by FPL includes contain or constitute competitively sensitive employee information, which if disclosed, would impair customers' interest in high quality and low cost electric service. FPL operates within a very competitive market for highly skilled and trained employees. Public disclosure of compensation and incentive information would enable competing employers to meet or beat the compensation offered by FPL. This would result in the loss of talented employees, including highly skilled employees with expertise in various fields and those who have completed training programs and courses with FPL, to competitors. This would also result in the inability to attract new talent, or conversely, the need to increase the level of compensation and incentives already paid in order to retain these employees and attract new talent. The quality of service and the cost of service implications would be detrimental to FPL and its customers. Additionally, this information is private to the employees identified, and disclosure would violate their personal rights of privacy. To the best of my knowledge, FPL has maintained the confidentiality of these documents and materials. Certain documents provided by FPL also include employee personnel information unrelated to compensation, duties, qualifications, or

responsibilities. Specifically, the information provided by FPL includes information such as personnel identification numbers.




