<u>Issue 1:</u> Should staff grant AT&T's Petition to waive SEEM penalties in the amount of \$35,200 for having to repost service quality measurement data in accordance with a provision in the SEEM Administrative Plan?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should grant AT&T's petition to waive the reposting penalty in the amount of \$35,200 payable to the state General Revenue Fund. **Issue 2:** Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: No. If the Commission approves staff's recommendation in Issue 1, the resulting Order will be issued as a Proposed Agency Action.
