**PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF
FLORIDA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY'S
CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY FACTOR**

Florida Public Utilities Company ("the Company"), through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to the requirements of this docket, hereby petitions the Commission for approval of the Company's conservation cost recovery factors for its consolidated natural gas division for the period January 2010 through December 2010. In support hereof, the Company states:

- 3) Pursuant to the requirements of this Docket, the Company has prefiled the conservation cost recovery forms supplied by the Electric & Gas Department in a manner consistent with the Department's instructions.

- 4) As indicated in the prefiled forms, the recoverable conservation costs for the period January 2010 through December 2010 are projected to be \$1,580,407. The conservation cost

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recovery true-up amount for the period January 2009 through December 2009 is an overrecovery of \$450,853.

5) The resulting net total projected conservation costs to be recovered for the period January 2010 through December 2010 are \$2,031,260. Based upon projected sales the appropriate levelized conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2010 through December 2010 are:

Residential	\$.05658
General Service	\$.02506
Large Volume Service	\$.02184
Large Volume Transportation Service	\$.02184

WHEREFORE, Florida Public Utilities Company petitions the Commission to approve the foregoing conservation cost recovery factors, to be applied to customer bills for the period January 2010 through December 2010, and to billings thereafter until other conservation cost recovery factors are approved by the Commission.
