BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Solomon L. Stamm who, being first duly sworn deposes and says:

1. My name is Solomon L. Stamm. I am currently employed by Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") as Controller Nuclear Fleet. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated in this affidavit.

2. I have reviewed the documents and information included in Exhibit A to FPL's Request for Confidential Classification. The documents or materials that I have reviewed and which are asserted by FPL to be proprietary confidential business information contains detailed data pertinent to FPL's settlement agreement with the U.S Government related to the Spent Nuclear Fuel. Specifically, the Spent Nuclear Fuel settlement represents reimbursement for incremental costs incurred by FPL because the U.S Department of Energy failed to meet its obligations. The disclosure of this detailed information on FPL's current and planned fuel-storage expenditures, as well as the specifics of its expected reimbursements would impair the efforts of FPL to contract for good and services on favorable terms and place FPL at a competitive disadvantage.

3. Consistent with the provisions of the Florida Administrative Code, such materials should remain confidential for a period of not less than 18 months. In addition, they should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business so that FPL can continue to maintain the confidentiality of these documents.


