Dear Ms. Cole:

Docket No. 080271-E1 was opened to monitor the status of joint-ownership discussions associated with Florida Power & Light's ("FPL's") Turkey Point Units 6 & 7, as directed in Order No. PSC-08-0237-FOF-EI.

By Order No. PSC-08-0237-FOF-EI, the Commission approved a stipulation which states in relevant part: "No later than July 1, 2009, FPL will continue its good faith discussions with FMEA, FMPA, and OUC, and will also commence good faith discussions of joint participation in Turkey Point Units 6 & 7 with JEA and Seminole. FPL will report the status of such ongoing status discussions to the FPSC every quarter thereafter."

FPL previously filed a letter which confirmed that, by July 1, 2009, FPL had continued or commenced good faith discussions with the parties listed in the Order and with others. The purpose of this letter is to provide its first Report on Joint Ownership Discussions (due by October 1, 2009).

As required by Order No. PSC-08-0237-FOF-EI, FPL has continued good faith discussions with FMEA, FMPA, OUC, JEA and Seminole. On two separate occasions meetings have been conducted: one on August 25, 2008 and another on April 27, 2009.

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August 25, 2008

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This meeting included participants from FPL, Ocala, FMPA, GRU, Homestead, JEA, OUC, Vero Beach, FMPA, GRU, JEA, Lakeland and Seminole. Discussion points included:

- A project overview of Turkey Point 6 & 7
- NRC requirements and the process for considering co-applicants for licensed ownership and operation
- Potential participation arrangements

April 27, 2009

This meeting included participants from FPL, Ocala, FMPA, GRU, Homestead, OUC, Vero Beach, JEA, Lakeland and Seminole. Discussion points included:

- A project update of Turkey Point 6 & 7 along with other nuclear projects in the U.S. and internationally
- Continued discussions on potential participation structures

The participants agreed that the next meeting will be held in late 2009 or early 2010.
