PRELIMINARY STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Florida City Gas submits this preliminary statement of issues and positions:

Issue 1: What are the appropriate final purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2008 through December 2008?

Florida City Gas: An under-recovery of \$1,404,419.

Issue 2: What are the actual/estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2009 through December 2009?

Florida City Gas: An over-recovery of \$1,472,219.

Issue 3: What are the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts to be collected during the period January 2010 through December 2010?

Florida City Gas: An over-recovery of \$67,800 for a true-up refund factor of 0.151 cents per therm.

Issue 4: What are the appropriate levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factors for the period January 2010 through December 2010?

Florida City Gas: 96.038cents per therm (before the regulatory assessment fee) or 96.521 cents per therm (with the regulatory assessment fee).

Issue 5: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?

Florida City Gas: The factors should be effective for all meter readings on or after January 1, 2010 and should apply for bills rendered for meter readings taken between January 1, 2010 and December 31, 2010.
