

AT&T FLORIDA'S NOTICE OF INTENT PURSUANT TO RULE 25-22.006

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files its Notice of Intent.

1. On October 27, 2009, AT&T Florida filed its Responses to the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission ("Staff's") First Set of Interrogatories and First Request for Production of Documents in the captioned docket.

2. The attachment to Item 6(b) to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories and the documents responsive to Item 5¹ of Staff's First Request for Production of Documents contain information that might be considered confidential business information to dPi Teleconnect, L.L.C.
