

CHAIRMAN CARTER: Good morning.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Good morning.

CHAIRMAN CARTER: I'd like to call this Agenda Conference to order. And, Commissioners, before we begin, I'd like to take a few moments, ever so briefly, first of all to welcome our colleague Dave Klement. He is -- prior to his appointment, Commissioner Klement served as Director of the Institute for Public Policy and Leadership at the University of South Florida where he created forums to address community needs, anticipated future challenges and strategies to tackle them, and engaged students in leadership and civic opportunities. He also worked as a journalist for more than four decades, most recently serving as an editorial page editor for the Bradenton Herald.

He's been married to his beautiful wife JoAnne for 31 years. She's a former journalist also and now she's a public relations marketing consultant. They have two wonderful children, five great grandchildren and they live in Bradenton.

5 **COMMISSIONER KLEMENT:** Thank you.

6 **CHAIRMAN CARTER:** Commissioner Edgar, you're
7 recognized.

8 **COMMISSIONER EDGAR:** Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

9 Welcome, Commissioner Klement. It is so nice
10 to have you here with us. And I mentioned to my staff
11 that you apparently bring lots and lots of goodwill in
12 that I think since you were appointed last week we've
13 had two cases that were going to hearing settle. So
14 there must be some goodwill, goodwill and cooperation in
15 the air, which I think is wonderful.

16 I'm so glad to have you join us. I remember
17 what seems like not all that long ago when I had my
18 first day in this room sitting in that very chair, I'm
19 sure we, we pretty much all, all do, and it was a bit of
20 a blur. But I hope that this job will be everything
21 that you hope it will be, and I look forward to working
22 with you and learning from you. And I hope that maybe
23 in January we can have a little more traditional
24 ceremony to you joining us then too.

25 **COMMISSIONER KLEMENT:** Thank you.

1 **CHAIRMAN CARTER:** Thank you.

2 Commissioner Argenziano.

3 **COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO:** Are you sure you
4 really want to be here? (Laughter.)

5 No. Welcome aboard. Just great to have a
6 full bench again, and you've come at a time when we have
7 a lot before us. I have no doubt that you'll just be
8 fine at it. I know the first days, as Commissioner
9 Edgar said, are, seem to be somewhat just a lot to
10 handle, and I, I have no doubt you'll do fine and we're
11 just looking forward to serving with you.

12 **COMMISSIONER KLEMENT:** Thank you.

13 **COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO:** Welcome, welcome
14 aboard.

15 **CHAIRMAN CARTER:** Thank you.

16 Commissioner Skop.

17 **COMMISSIONER SKOP:** Thank you, Mr. Chair.

18 I just wanted to welcome Commissioner Klement
19 to the Commission. We look forward to having you
20 onboard, and it gives us a full panel of Commissioners.
21 And I know that at least from my own experience coming
22 into the Commission can be a little bit overwhelming,
23 but we have a wonderful staff that's here to support
24 you, and I look forward to serving with you on the
25 Commission. Thank you.

7 opposed to great.
