

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files its Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

On November 9, 2009, AT&T Florida filed its Rebuttal Testimony of P.L. (Scot)
 Ferguson and Cindy Clark in the captioned docket, along with a Notice of Intent to Request
 Specified Confidential Classification.

2. *Revised* Exhibit No. CAC-4 to Cindy Clark's Rebuttal Testimony contains information that, upon information and belief, is considered confidential business information to DSL Internet Corporation d/b/a DSLi ("DSLi").
