Dear Chairman Argenziano and Commissioners:

This serves to advise the Florida Public Service Commission (FPSC or Commission) of apparent illegal and criminal conduct on the part of a Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) executive vice president. Based on information and belief and credible witness testimony, it appears this FPL vice president solicited an \$800,000 kick-back payment from a company in a (quid pro quo) for a continued business relationship with FPL.

Moreover, based on information and belief and credible witness testimony, it appears that FPL executive level managers, illegally discharged several nuclear workers at FPL's St. Lucie Nuclear Power Plant after these individuals notified FPL executive managers about a significant nuclear safety-related concern which may still remain unresolved.

To the extent that this material evidence appears to directly contradict recent statements made to the Commission by the FPL Group Chief Executive Officer, Lewis Hay, it is imperative that the Commission act in a timely manner to investigate the substance of this evidence to determine whether FPL's recent testimony given under oath in Docket No. 080677-EI is credible or should have been relied upon by the Commission in setting FPL's electric rates.

To the extent that there appears to be criminal wrongdoing on the part of an FPL executive vice president, the undersigned respectfully requests that the Commission solicit the assistance of the Florida Attorney General to initiate an a "criminal" MENTER DATE

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investigation of FPL.

In closing, the undersigned stands ready to assist the Commission and the Florida Attorney General in this most serious matter upon request.
