Staff completed its review of the Request for Confidential Classification submitted by Progress Energy Florida on January 11, 2009 (document no.00241-10). This request relates to staff's examination of a complaint received by the Commission alleging Code of Ethics violations by Progress Energy Employees.

Staff believes that this request, for the reasons cited by the company, appears confidential in nature and harm to the company or its ratepayers will result from public disclosure, with the following two exceptions:

Page 1, last ¶ (titled "Alleged Events"), Lines 1-2: employee personnel information. §366.093(3)(c)(f), F.S.

Page 2, last ¶ (titled "Alleged Events"), portions of Lines 1-3: employee personnel information. §366.093(3)(c)(f), F.S.

In both cases, staff's report makes reference to information *included* within the complaint document and not information provided directly by the company. This complaint document is public record; therefore, staff does not recommend approval of these two exceptions.
