Description of Change: Currently, the aggregate reports for Firm Order Confirmation and Reject Response Completeness include affiliate data. The 12month reports for this measure are correct. AT&T proposes to modify the code to exclude the affiliate data from the Firm Order Confirmation and Reject Response Completeness measure. (RQ10455)

#### Impact of Change:

Description of Change: Currently, the SOA code may extract incorrect OCNs for LNP trigger orders with multiple versions. AT&T proposes to modify the code to only extract OCNs from the latest version of the LSR. (RQ10233)

-For the January 2010 data-month, the CLEC metric for the SOA UNE disaggregation results would change from 96.58% to 96.59%.

Description of Change: Currently, the SOA code does not differentiate between "Listed", "Non-List", and "Non-Pub" list type codes. AT&T proposes to modify the code to differentiate between "Listed", "Non-List", and "Non-Pub" list type codes. (RQ10424)

#### Impact of Change:

-For the January 2010 data-month, the CLEC metric for the SOA Resale disaggregation results would change from 95.87% to 95.89%.

-For the January 2010 data-month, the CLEC metric for the SOA UNE disaggregation results would change from 96.58% to 96.75%.

(5) Affected Measures: OVRD SA-3 Offered Versus Requested Due Date [OVRD] Description of Change: Currently, the 12-month reports for the Offered Versus Requested Due Date metric uses records marked within the Proportion Map. AT&T proposes to modify the code in accordance with the calculation methodology to use records marked within the Benchmark Map. (RQ10454)
