Case Background

On May 15, 2009, Mad Hatter Utility, Inc. (MHU) and Paradise Lakes Utility, LLC (PLU) filed a joint complaint with the Commission against Verizon Florida, LLC (Verizon). After the complaint was received, Docket No. 090313-PU was established and the matter was set for hearing.

On January 20, 2010, Verizon submitted a motion to suspend proceedings because the parties had agreed to settle the matter. By Order No. PSC-10-0052-PCO-PU, issued January 20, 2010, the Commission granted the motion.

On March 3, 2010, MHU and PLU filed a notice to voluntarily dismiss their complaint against Verizon, with prejudice, due to the fact that the parties reached a settlement agreement.

Discussion of Issues

Issue 1: Should the Commission acknowledge Mad Hatter Utility, Inc. and Paradise Lakes Utility, LLC's notice of voluntary dismissal, with prejudice?

<u>**Recommendation**</u>: Yes, the Commission should acknowledge Mad Hatter Utility, Inc. and Paradise Lakes Utility, LLC's notice of voluntary dismissal, with prejudice. (**Curry, Brooks**)

<u>Staff Analysis</u>: The law is clear that the plaintiff's right to take a voluntary dismissal is absolute. <u>Fears v. Lundsford</u>, 314 So. 2d 578, 579 (Fla. 1975).

Therefore, staff recommends that the Commission acknowledge Mad Hatter Utility, Inc. and Paradise Lakes Utility, LLC's notice of voluntary dismissal, with prejudice.
