Docket No. 080271-EI was opened to monitor the status of joint ownership discussions associated with Florida Power & Light's ("FPL's") Turkey Point Units 6 & 7, as directed in Order No. PSC-08-0237-FOF-EI.

By Order No. PSC-08-0237-FOF-EI, the Commission approved a stipulation which states in relevant part: "No later than July 1, 2009, FPL will continue its good faith discussions with FMEA, FMPA, and OUC, and will also commence good faith discussions of joint participation in Turkey Point Units 6 & 7 with JEA and Seminole. FPL will report the status of such ongoing status discussions to the FPSC every quarter thereafter." As required by Order No. PSC-08-0237-FOF-EI, FPL has continued good faith discussions with FMEA, FMPA, OUC, JEA, and Seminole.

Meetings with potential joint owners occurred on August 25, 2008 and April 27, 2009. Those meetings were described in FPL's first quarterly report, dated September 24, 2009. The next meeting is currently scheduled for May 21, 2010. FPL will update the Commission on its next meeting and any subsequent meetings in future quarterly reports.
